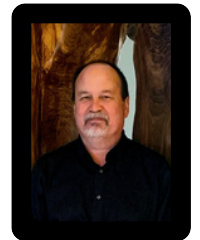

Since his art school days, Ric Jones has focused on graphic design and art direction, but now has more time to pursue fine art. He is drawn to the immediacy of photography and combines it with his love of serigraphy to create collages printed on quality watercolor paper using inkjet technology, achieving a silkscreen-like effect. He incorporates "digital found objects" into his work, using 3D models of industrial objects repurposed in Cinema 4D, inspired by a teacher who worked with physical found objects.

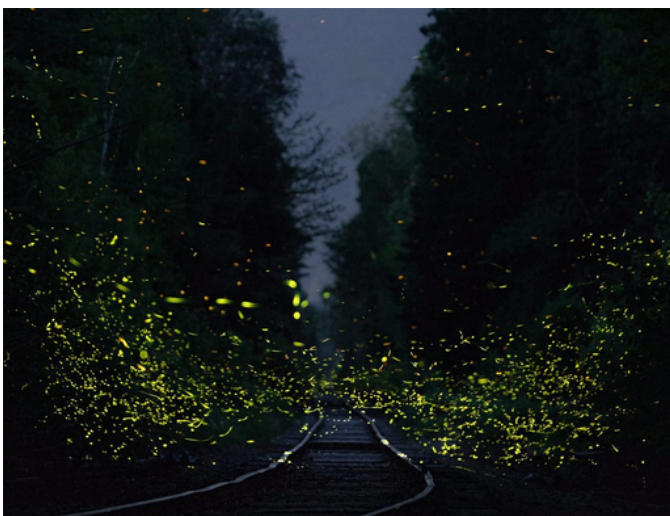
