At Last, Almost There!

These pieces premiered as works in progress in February 2023 at Buzzsaw Coffee, then again completed at Barrel 135 in March of this year. The theme, like the paintings, is abstract: the evolution of seeming chaos towards the Greater Good. My intention with this body of work is to express the complexities, layers, cohesion and moving parts of the All, while using a visually beautiful and visceral brush. I began by gathering different symbolic elements that would be included or not, somewhere in the entire body of work. These images would either come to me in contemplation, or as a flash from out of the blue. After preparing the ground with acrylic wash and acetate maquettes created from the canvas wrappings, the various symbols each found their place. My job was to not over think but rather to respond to the canvas and paint. I am very happy with the result. This collection of work is the first time I have attempted multiple large format paintings -- the smallest being 40x30" and the largest 60x48". The paintings are all a multi-media mix of acrylic, oil, fiber and a few sundries. For this exhibit, I have also included my polyptych, The Women's March (2017) in this exhibit. I felt it timely to reconsider. It is an earlier abstract work and also fits perfectly with the theme of this show, At Last, Almost There!











